

How to submit the competition entry for the Beta development phase of CGMAC 2010

Deadlines of the competition:

1. Registration, last date to submit 13.6.2010. Fill out and return the registration form
2. Plan, last date to submit 30.6.2010. Write two page plan about the application with two pages attachments.
3. First demo of the application, last date to submit 25.7.2010. Feedback to teams by 2.8.2010
4. Beta, last date to submit 15.8.2010

Winners of the first phase will be announced 1.9.2010

The written competition entries must be submitted in electronic format as a text file (e.g. in Microsoft Word format or pdf) and software with documentation in zip file by email to mob@viherio.com.

Submitting an entry requires an e-mail address to which the registration activation message will be sent. Feedback on the work will be provided to the same email.

You can register and set up a team at an early stage, before submitting the work. the earlier you submit the registration the more time you will have to make a good application since technical documentation will be provided shortly after registration is received.

Evaluation of the competition entries

The evaluators will pay attention to:

- Robustness, application must be stable in defined platform
- Usability, application will be used mostly on the golf course during the game so UI must be clear and very easy to use
- Innovativeness
- Quality of documentatation

Formal Requirements

Following requirements should be met in order to participate. Not being consistent with following or being late from the submission deadlines written in the beginning of this document might lead to disqualification.

1. Registration:

Fill out the official form downloaded from this page by typing and return to mob@viherio.com. Handwritten forms are not accepted.

2. Plan

- Frontpage, with 150-character public description about application idea **in English**

- 2 pages description
 - platform where application will work
 - technical requirements of the platform (mobile phone)
 - application functionalities
 - communicating with GREENi-system
 - possible other information sources
 - what makes this application better than the others
- At most 2 pages of appendixes with UI sketches

The competition entry with appendixes must be in a same document.

Fonts and Margins

Upper heading

- Font: Arial (Bold)
- Size: 16
- Numbering: 1, 2, 3...

Lower heading

- Font: Arial (Bold, Italic)
- Size: 14
- Numbering: 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 2.1, 2.2, 2.3

Body type

- Font: Times New Roman
- Size: 12
- Spaced: 1,5 rows

3. First demo

ZIP-file with application, installation instructions and freely formulated documentation.

4. Beta

ZIP-file with application, installation instructions, freely formulated documentation and plans for the further development.

Every participant is responsible for successful submission of their competition entry.
